

Low-income children of color are at high risk of severe RSV

Tragically, Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) causes an estimated 100 to 300 deaths each year among children younger than age five. Access to preventative immunizations for all eligible infants and young children will be critical to reduce RSV disease.

Take action now - let your policymakers know this is an important health equity issue that affects our most vulnerable.

HOSPITALIZATIONS

RSV leads to 58,000 to 80,000 cases of hospitalizations a year in children younger than 5.
